

Unitarian Universalist Fellowship Denominational House at Chautauqua

Welcome! Here's what you need to know.

The UU Fellowship at Chautauqua offers affordable accommodations just steps from Bestor Plaza in a modern, garden environment that is fully air-conditioned. There is no elevator service. For photos: <https://www.uufchq.org/accommodations.html>

The Unitarian Universalist Denominational House is within walking distance of most major activities. A bus/tram service provides free transportation throughout the Institution.

The UUDH has six bedrooms available during the nine-week season, one is handicapped-accessible. Each two bedrooms shares one bathroom*. Motorized chairs and scooters are not able to be accommodated in the house.

*There is one handicapped-accessible room, which has its own bath

Shared space includes use of the communal kitchen in which simple meals may be prepared, living room, dining room, and patio. WiFi is available to everyone. The space is occasionally used for UU-related small gatherings.

We attempt to give preference to those who might not otherwise be able to afford the CHQ experience and ask that you consider that when contemplating applying for a reservation. Owners of property in or near the Institution are ineligible for UUDH accommodations.

During the season, admission to CHQ requires a gate pass. Those are not included with our accommodations. Children and those over 90 may qualify for free gate passes, contact chq.org for current pricing. Paid parking is available in the Main lot.

Arrivals may begin after 3:00 PM on Saturday, departures must be complete before 10:00 AM the following Saturday.

Applications for the following year will be accepted beginning on July 1st. Applications from members of a UU Congregation who have not yet been a UUDH guest will be considered first, followed by all UU Congregation members, and then non-Unitarian Universalists. All applications must be accompanied by a check in the amount of the full payment due. Beginning on September 1st applications will be processed in the order they have been received. Applications received after September 1st will be considered in the order they're received. **All communication will be via email.**

Please write legibly or type, if we can't read your application we can't process it.

Pets, smoking of any kind and illegal substances are not permitted in or on the UUDH property.

Finances

A full payment of \$550 per room, plus linen/towel costs, must accompany each application. Checks should be made payable to the UUFC. Your check will be returned to you or shredded if your request cannot be fulfilled.

Linens andTowel:

Guests may bring their own linens and towels, or have them provided by the UUDH. Towels provided by the UUDH must remain in the building, supply your own towels for beach or gym use. UUDH linen packages include sheets, a pillowcase, a bath towel, a hand towel & a washcloth.

Cancellations:

Cancellations of confirmed reservations result in additional management costs and potential lost income. If you cancel on or before April 1st we will refund \$200. If you Cancel after April 1st you will not receive a refund unless we can negotiate a replacement reservation, in which case there will be a \$200 refund.
